Concession ticket prices apply to holders of Age, Invalid, TPI and Supporting Parent Pensions, Unemployed or full time students. Please quote your Pension / Unemployment / Student number in the space provided overleaf.

Please note: travel concessions and Seniors Cards may not be used as proof of eligibility as they are not means tested.

Children under 13 years are free.

Companion Cards

Holders of a Companion card will be issued with a second ticket for their companion at no charge. Companion cards are available for people with a disability who require a companion to enable them to access community activities. Companion cards must be presented upon arrival.
